## THE PHARMACY COUNCIL ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation with the Pharmacy Council, under section 45 of the Pharmacy Council Act

## 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Pharmacy Council (Levying of Fees and Registration of Pharmacists) Regulations 2017.**

- In these regulations —
  "Act" means the Pharmacy Council Act 2015.
- **3.** The registration fee payable under section 18(1)(f) of the Act shall be 2,000 rupees.
- **4.** The processing fee payable under section 18(3)(b)(iv) of the Act shall be 1,000 rupees.

**5.** The registration fee payable under section 1 8(5)(*c*) shall be 2,000 rupees.

6. The annual fee payable under section 18(5)(c) shall be 2,000 rupees.

**7.** A duplicate certificate of registration issued under section 18(6) of the Act shall be issued on payment of a fee of 2,000 rupees.

8. The annual fee payable under section 19(1)—

- (a) shall be 2,000 rupees; and
- (b) in the case of late payment of annual fee, shall be 3,000 rupees.

**9.** An application under section 21(3) for the recording of additional qualification in the field of pharmacy obtained by a pharmacist shall be made on payment of a fee of 1,000 rupees.

**10.** The fee payable for registration as pre-registration trainee under section 22(4) shall be 1,000 rupees.

11. The registration fee payable under section 24(1)(d) of the Act shall be 5,000 rupees.

**12.** The processing fee payable under section 24(2)(b)(vi) of the Act shall be 3,000 rupees.

**13**. The registration fee payable under section 24(4)(c) of the Act shall be 3,000 rupees.

**14.** A registered pharmacist shall forthwith notify the Registrar, by registered letter, of any change in his address or if he will be absent from the country for a period of more than 6 months.
